**Additional Information / Prior Funding History:**

A portion of the federal funding requires State matching funds in the amount of \$150,000. The match requirement will be met using an existing capital appropriation for the repair and maintenance of the Pioneers' Homes.

**Project Description/Justification:**

The Sitka Pioneers' Home Preservation and Rehabilitation project will include repairs to the roof, exterior and main entry.

A matching grant in the amount of \$150,000 was awarded for preservation of the Sitka Pioneers' Home by the National Park Service as part of the "Save America's Treasures" initiative to preserve significant historic properties. The state will match the federal funds with an existing capital improvement appropriation for Pioneers' Home repairs.

Federal funds in the amount of \$500,000 have also been provided by the Department of Housing and Urban Development, at the direction of Congress, for the rehabilitation of this facility.
