Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

Construct a shuttle ferry boat to carry passengers, vehicles, and freight between the Hollis terminal at Clark Bay and Ketchikan. The Hollis ferry is the system planned by the Interisland Ferry Authority, formed by six Southeast municipal governments. It would operate one or two round trips daily from Hollis (Clark Bay) to Ketchikan offering a routine schedule. This ferry, in combination with the Metlakatla ferry offers the opportunity to take the M/V Aurora out of service in Southeast, a considerable annual savings to the Alaska Marine Highway System.
