This position compiles and maintains almost all of the databases used in the annual production of population estimates and projections for the state. The position must do all the cleanup, coding and tabulation of the entire PFD file, all vital statistics, school enrollment data, food stamp data, and survey annually group quarters and military populations. The position produces tabulations that are the input data for both our population estimates and projections. Funding for the position is anticipated from the Dept. of Community & Economic Development.</p>

The Employment Security Division, Job Training Programs component, requests to amend the FY2002 State Training Employment Program (STEP) budget submission by \$500.0, from a total of \$4,560.1 to an amended total of \$5,060.1.

The authorization increase will be added to the service delivery areas (SDA) grants line, which will provide competitive grants to organizations and individuals in need of STEP services. Estimated distribution of these additional funds would see roughly \$180.0 allocated to the Anchorage Mat-Su service area and approximately \$320.0 allocated to the Balance of State.

It is anticipated that approximately 200 additional participants will be served with these added funds. These funds will be directed towards expanded access to state and employer sponsored training programs and services including; 1) industry specific on-the-job and classroom training, 2) job search assistance and other supportive services, and 3) vocational counseling and career guidance. Priorities for additional services could be directed towards those areas of the State that have been most seriously impacted by declines in commercial fisheries.

Prior to FY98, fiscal year end lapsing amounts in the STEP account were deposited back into the Unemployment Insurance Trust Fund. Beginning in the FY98 budget, lapsing STEP funds have been carried forward in the STEP account.

The State Independent Living Council requests an increment of \$90.0 to expand outreach services to persons with disabilities in rural Alaska.

Five regional centers in Alaska receive grants funded with a combination of state, federal and private resources. Each center that accepts any state or federal funding is responsible for providing Independent Living services in a specified region. However, none of the centers is adequately funded to serve every community and every area of a region. There have been no increases in the general fund contribution to IL since the State first offered the program in 1984. As a result, some rural communities and some areas of the state, such as Western Alaska, have been under served or not served at all which results in increased costs to the State for institutional and primary care programs.

The investment in IL services provides substantial savings for the general fund. For example, 85% of all persons who are placed in long-term institutions are Medicaid funded, at an average cost of more than \$90,000 per individual per year. In FY99, Alaskan Centers for IL were directly responsible for successfully relocating 18 people from nursing homes to their chosen communities. Another 165 individuals received services that helped avoid their being sent to long-term care facilities. The one year savings in Medicaid costs alone for those 183 individuals are estimated to be over \$14 million.

This investment of an additional \$90,000 in this program will yield a significant long term savings to the general fund.
