Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

All facilities with a fuel tank over 660 gallon capacity, or total combined capacity over 1,320 gallons, require a Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasures (SPCC) plan under the Clean Water Act. The SPCC plans must be reviewed and updated every 3 years by a licensed engineer. State and military facilities are not exempt under this Act.

Funds will pay for the preparation and revision of these plans for facilities in proportion to cost sharing responsibilities. Noncompliance can lead to a \$10,000 per day fine. State and military facilities are not exempt under the act.
