**Additional Information / Prior Funding History:**

Examples are site drilling for soils content where the Forest Service is constructing a road or for paving a road inside a park while the state is paving a road in the area. FY2004 - \$18,500,000; FY2003 - \$13,500,000; FY2002 - \$13,500,000; FY2001 - \$10,500,000; FY2000 - \$10,500,000; FY1999 - \$10,500,000.

**Project Description/Justification:**

In general, this program supports a cooperation between federal agencies and the state, where the state has specialized knowledge or can combine work for a federal agency with work being done by the state to save costs for the federal agency.

In the past this has been used for special soils drilling analysis requested by the Forest Service in support of the Forest Highway Program, road maintenance for federal-owned roads and paving a state park road for the US Park Service while our contractor was paving a state-owned road. This source has been used to construct projects for the Denali Commission, including Pile Bay Road Rehabilitation and Rural Dust Control Demonstration Project.
