Project Description/Justification:

Project provides access to the nearest deep water port site in the Cordova vicinity. This is the selected location for a new Oil Spill Response Facility and will service cruise ships and timber loading. This project is being managed by the Native Village of Eyak under the Bureau of Indian Affairs Indian Reservation Roads Program. The port facility is being funded with Exxon Valdez Oil Spill settlement funds. This project will lower transportation costs to and from Cordova and enhance economic development and tourism.
