Project Description/Justification:

The skating rink at Taku Elementary School is old and is beginning to fall apart. This skating rink is used by students for physical education classes, the after school program, children and families in the neighborhood and the PTA has a family skate night every year that is well attended. Parents in the neighborhood flood and maintain the rink all winter long.

Due to budgetary constraints, the Anchorage School District no longer provides maintenance of ice rinks for elementary schools. The school's PTA will do fundraising for this project, but can not expect a large contribution amount solely from the school community.

\$50,000 is requested from the State to refurbish the ice rink including filling cracks in the asphalt, and repairing or replacing the boards and poles around the rink.
