Project Description/Justification:

AMHS requires an additional bollard to ensure a proper lead on mooring (spring) lines. Modifications are also required to the bull rail (rail at the edge of the dock) to allow vehicles better access to the loading ramp. Modifications to the catwalk are needed as the the current catwalk has a "frame" around it requiring shoreside linehandlers to shift the line from hand-to-hand to get the line around the uprights to get it to the bollard (this is a safety hazard).
