Project Description/Justification:

The project will support the major expansion to the Fairbanks Memorial Hospital. The City has closed 19th and 20th Avenue to through-traffic. Cowles Street and 21st Avenue have now become important for access and traffic circulation to the hospital facility and employee parking areas. Both Cowles Street and 21st Avenue require new pavement and drainage improvements. The addition of sidewalks will serve adjacent residential neighborhoods and schools.
