Project Description/Justification:

The Department received an appropriation of \$4 million general funds in the FY07 capital budget to rehabilitate and widen the Kenai Spur Road between Milepost 3 and Milepost 8. This appropriation was to supplement a \$5 million FY05 legislative appropriation for the same purpose. Average daily traffic data does not support the need for major rehabilitation and widening of this road segment. A more immediate need of these funds would be to support the rehabilitation and paving of the Sterling Highway from Mackie Lake Intersection to Soldotna. The Senate Finance Committee adopted a version of the capital bill which reappropriated a portion of the FY05 Kenai Spur Road rehabilitation project for the Sterling Highway project. It would be appropriate to redirect the FY07 capital project for the same purpose.
