Project Description/Justification:

The Deadhorse Airport Master Plan was completed in 1987. Since then, there have been several changes in and around the airport. In addition, there is a significant interest in leasing airport property and a plan must be developed to reduce potential conflicts between commercial and general aviation users. Issues such as security and safety are critical planning factors that should be addressed in this Master Plan Update, particularly with the increasing possibility of the construction of a new gasline. An update to the existing airport master plan is needed to address these issues and to adjust the Department's course of development at Deadhorse Airport.
