The department has numerous remote bunkhouses and temporary employee housing units located in various locations across the state. Several of these sites are very old/substandard and have had little or no maintenance or upgrades in many years; some need outright replacement. Many of these units are remote with limited access. This project provides funding to upgrade and retrofit several remote site bunkhouses and remote field housing units over the next three years. Initially the department will upgrade/replace a very substandard and old bunkhouse facility at the Wood River research site outside of Dillingham and follow with a series of upgrades and/or replacements across the state.

Project Description/Justification:
