Additional Information / Prior Funding History:

Construction of the Juneau facility was made by FY99 \$1,500,000 (CH 139, SLA98, pg 48). \$25,000 of this project vetoed.

Project Description/Justification:

The Juneau Indoor Shooting Facility was originally constructed to include an indoor archery range. The division did not have the funds to complete this portion of the facility when the building was first constructed. At the time of initial construction, the building footprint was made large enough to accept the future expansion. The division has worked in partnership with the City and Borough of Juneau (CBJ) to build the facility. This partnering was built on the expectation of completing the archery portion of the facility. The CBJ has helped the division with funds to build the external frame to accommodate archery and to pay for a waterline to the property. Funds are needed for internal walls and construction costs. The division is working with constituent groups to help fund the project.
