Additional Information / Prior Funding History:

The total cost of this project is \$3,629,800. The Department of Fish and Game's total obligation is only the \$1,500,000 in federal receipts. The \$2,129,800 non-federal match will be provided by the City of Whittier. The federal grant was awarded late in FY07, and due to the project timeline, no funds were expended in FY07 and no funds will be expended in FY08.

Project Description/Justification:

This project will construct 15 new transient moorage floats that will provide much needed docking space for 30 large (26' or greater) recreational power boats at the existing Whittier Harbor. The project will provide for construction of a retaining wall and bulkhead, which are necessary structures for attachment of the mooring floats, as well as a boardwalk, and dockside electrical and potable water services.
