**Project Description/Justification:**

This project will establish a permanent inland route that is less susceptible to flooding and erosion and will also enhance the community link between Barrow, Browerville, and the National Atmospheric Research Laboratory. A section of the existing beach road has been degraded due to repeated seasonal flood events.
