### RESOLUTION NO. FY 09-15

#### A RESOLUTION OF THE OLD HARBOR CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING A 2009 STATE LEGISLATIVE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS PRIORITY LIST

WHEREAS, the Old Harbor City Council is a municipal government representing the citizens of the City of Old Harbor; and

WHEREAS, the City of Old Harbor is recognized as a Second Class City by the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the City of Old Harbor has developed improvements and infrastructure needs for their citizens and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the City of Old Harbor CIP need are identified, prioritized, and forwarded to the Kodiak Island Borough for inclusion into an island wide list to be considered by the Alaska legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE OLD HARBOR CITY COUNCIL THAT: The City of Old Harbor's 2008 State Legislative Capital Improvement Projects Priority list is as follows:

- 1.) Hydroelectric Power Project      \$6,000,000  
This project is to provide a clean renewable source of electrical power for the residents of Old Harbor and possible opportunities for economic growth.
- 2.) Water System/ Sewage Lagoon      \$2,000,000  
This project is to design and construct a new infiltration gallery and water treatment plant and tank for the water service in Old Harbor. It would also include the repair of fence around the sewage lagoon.
- 3.) Dock and Harbor Improvements      \$6,000,000  
This project is to include a redesigned small boat harbor to accommodate the charter boat fleet and sports fishing industry developing in Old Harbor along with the existing commercial fleet that works out of our community.

- 4.) Tank Farm Re-Plumbing \$15,000  
Re-configure piping in Tank Farm to allow for storage of variable amounts of Diesel #1 and DF2 in existing Tanks.
  
- 5.) Spill Response Vessel & Storage Shed \$75,000  
The interests by commercial carriers and in the interest of safety this project would provide for the lighting of the local airport and aid in getting the F.A.A to establish an instrument approach for this airport, and provide a Fire Hydrant for emergency use.
  
- 6.) Airport Improvements \$450,000  
The interests by commercial carriers and in the interest of safety this project would provide for the lighting of the local airport and aid in getting the F.A.A to establish an instrument approach for this airport, and provide a Fire Hydrant for emergency use.
  
- 7.) Maintenance Equipment \$400,000  
The City is need of a D6 or D4 size dozer in order to provide the necessary continued maintenance of the landfill site, roads, and other public works the City has charge of.
  
- 8.) Park Renovation \$50,000  
The City is in need of materials for a new basketball court pad. In order to make the park safer, clean up of alders and maintenance of the swings and slides will be required.
