We the City of Lower Kalskag Council support the efforts of the Native Village of Kalskag on pursuing a Capital Project Grant, through the state of Alaska to renovate the Multi-purpose building in which will house a fire station and a fire truck. It is for the best interest of the Citizens of Lower Kalskag, as well as the citizens of Kalskag.

In the City of Lower Kalskag we've had 2 deaths by fire and 5 residential homes burned down, 1 of the homes were saved by the efforts of the local residents who used their own fire extinguishers to help put out the fire. The dump in Lower Kalskag has caught on fire numerous times, and burnt out of control once.

With approximately 88 residential homes in Lower Kalskag, and with the students of George Morgan Sr. High School attending school here at Zackar Levi Elementary School located in Lower Kalskag.

Both Upper and Lower Kalskag will utilize the fire equipment when needed.

The City of Lower Kalskag has a fire Chief through Rural Cap with 5 volunteer trainees who will work with the VPSO. The VPSO who will head the fire station crew, delegate duties, supervise and participate in fire training drills
