Project Description/Justification:

Skagway experiences a very large volume of cruise ship traffic, with four to five cruise ships nearly each day of the week during the cruise ship season. For this small town, which has a winter population of approximately 850, this translates to a huge amount of municipal resources dedicated purely to cruise ship passenger traffic. Entire sections of town do not operate during the winter months, yet continue to exist only for the cruise ship industry. Skagway enjoys a positive economic result from the cruise ship industry and devotes a lot of time and resources to ensure the safety and enjoyment of the cruise ship passengers.
