Projects include those that involve the cleanup of leaking underground storage tank sites. There are currently 501 open Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) sites in Alaska, and the Contaminated Sites program plans to use the funds to cleanup 10-20 so-called "orphan" sites (sites where the responsible party cannot be located or is not viable). These funds will be managed by the Contaminated Sites program.
