¹ Includes only funds appropriated and RPLs to state agencies, not funds appropriated directly from federal agencies to communities or other organizations.

² The jobs reporting method was revised from the first reporting period. Jobs are now calculated by dividing the number of hours reimbursed by ARRA funds by the number of hours available in the work period. Unlike expenditures, jobs are reported on a quarterly rather than cumulative basis.

³ Some of the grants appropriated by the Legislature are not subject to ARRA section 1512 reporting. Recipients of these funds, however, continue to submit quarterly federal financial reports.
