Re: VPO/VPSO in Elim /W&S Upgrade 09 season


Currently Elim is in the process of advertising for the VPO position. Our previous VPO moved to Anchorage. The City of Elim have a 1% tax in place to help pay for the VPO. The VPO duties are working with the State Troopers, on call to Elim residents and the curfew.


The VPSO situation/ Gina Appolloni stated that 7 positions are funded in this area. We have one application in , and if hired he will be put on the waiting list. The City of Elim do not have housing available for a VPSO. A question was raised from the Elim IRA Council and Elim City Council about rent and utilities if we were to rent a house for him or her.

Any help regarding this will be greatly appreciated, as we are still without a basic need for Law Enforcement in our village.

There is a question if the east side of our village for water and sewer upgrade is funded. If you can help us on this it will help. Currently the sewer is done on the west side, and the water is scheduled to be started in June of 2009. In talking with ANTHC in Anchorage and the construction foreman the water and sewer will last more than the 2 years planned. The east side will be in the 09 state budget in December, according to ANTHC.

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


