Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The Tri-Valley Fire Department needs a new well at the fire station to accommodate water demands needed for fire response. Currently, the fire department operates from a residential well to fill tanker trucks. If there is a high-volume incident, they must travel three miles to the Golden Valley Electric Power Plant to use their well. Construction of a new well will also improve the ISO rating for the community, which could positively affect insurance costs. This is a priority of the Denali Borough.
