The Soldotna Creek Park is an old State of Alaska maintenance yard that the City acquired and has been converted to a beautiful community park and playground. This park will be the primary community park in Soldotna where virtually all of the City of Soldotna outdoor events will be hosted. Efforts to design and construct this park are ongoing.

Development of Soldotna Creek Park includes the addition of pedestrian trails, signage, a performance pavilion, and landscaping. Further, to ensure that future development of the park is done in a sustainable manner, the funding awarded will be used to study additional recreational and commercial uses of the park, parking needs, traffic patterns, and health and safety requirements. The study will also address the coordination needs between state, federal, and other affected entities regarding the future development.
