**Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

The City of Nondalton maintains roads and access for the community. This equipment is not usable as it is, and the alternative would be new equipment. The City would like to purchase parts for this equipment rather than purchasing new. The project will include the purchase and freight; local funds will cover the mechanic for 8 hours a day 2 weeks all associated with payroll and taxes. The equipment needs are: replace engine and hydraulic gears, replace each 4 tires, sleeves, and bushings for the L70C Volvo Loader and replace sleeves and bushings on the 580 case loader/back hoe.

The purchase and freight will be the spring of 2010; mechanic will work on in the month of September and expected to be complete by October 2010.

**WHEREAS**, the last update provided to the borough was November 14, 2008 for the FY 08 budget year, and




