This request is for the purchase of 12 Signal Malfunction Management Units (MMU's) for use on all signal systems "outside" the Municipality of Anchorage (MatSu and Kenai Peninsula). Each signalized intersection is equipped with a controller cabinet. One of the components in the cabinet is a MMU. These units will be used to swap out the existing MMU's for testing on a rotational basis in compliance with national standards. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage and by improving the mobility of people and goods.
