Project Description/Justification:

The Pavement Condition Indexes and Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) inspector's Letters of Correction require this project to satisfy concerns about surface irregularity as well as the potential for Foreign Object Debris (FOD) damage at Kodiak. Additionally, FAA policy requires addressing runway safety area deficiencies at certified airports prior to 2015 and applies special discretionary funding for this work (\$25,000,000 per runway).
