If the full state grant match is not forthcoming in FY2011, the match could be provided in phases as noted below:



DISTRICT 31 1	\$5,600,000	\$0	\$5,600,000
<p>120th Ave Upgrade - Oceanview Elementary to Old Seward Hwy</p> <p>Scope: This project will construct missing pedestrian facilities and upgrade a local road adjacent to Oceanview Elementary. Improvements may include a student drop off and street lighting.</p> <p>Need: High density residential development along 120th Avenue has increased pedestrian and vehicular traffic. The existing strip-paved road, drainage, street lighting, and pedestrian facilities are inadequate.</p> <p>Status: A technical memo was completed for the western segment of this road. The recommendation from the memo was to construct all improvements to 120th Avenue at the same time instead of by phases. Funding is proposed as a 50/50 partnership with local bond funds and state grants. Additional design funding is proposed.</p>

<p>121st Ave Storm Drain - Mary Dr to Ellen Ave</p> <p>Scope: This project will install an underground storm drain system to address localized flooding.</p> <p>Need: The area has inadequate drainage infrastructure. The Klatt Area Drainage Study identified this storm drain project as a priority.</p> <p>Status: This project has not started. State grant funding is proposed.</p>

<p>123rd Ave/Ellen Ave/Pattis Ave Storm - Mary Ave to Johns Rd</p> <p>Scope: This project will install underground storm drains to address flooding and ice build up.</p> <p>Need: The Klatt Area Drainage Study identifies this as a priority storm drain location. No storm drain facilities currently exist.</p> <p>Status: Project funding is proposed with a combination of a state grant and local road bonds.</p>			
DISTRICT 28 2 + DISTRICT 31	\$2,400,000	\$0	\$2,400,000
<p>Furrow Creek at Clippership Ct and Mariner Dr Drainage Improvements</p> <p>Scope: This project will upgrade the existing culvert carrying Furrow Creek under Clippership and Mariner Drives. It is likely the Corps of Engineers will require a bridge.</p> <p>Need: Area development has increased drainage flows in Furrow Creek and the existing system is not adequate to handle the increasing flows. As a result, flooding has occurred in the road and on private property causing damage to Mariner Drive and property owners. This project is a priority for the Old Seward/Oceanview Community Council.</p> <p>Status: This project has not started. Full project funding is proposed with a combination of a state grant and local road bonds.</p>

<p>Furrow Creek Improvements - Turnagain Arm to Elmora Rd</p> <p>Scope: The project will start as a study of the area that will include identification of problems and recommended solutions, including capital project recommendations.</p> <p>Need: Increased development on the hillside has increased drainage flows in Furrow Creek. The existing creek channel and culverts are not adequate to handle flows. As a result, flooding occurs.</p> <p>Status: A drainage study is underway which will identify specific improvements to be funded.</p>			

DISTRICT 31	PRIORITY # 8	Oceanview/Cross/ Brandon St Surface Rehab - Johns Rd to Old Seward Hwy This project will replace or overlay the pavement.	Estimated Cost \$1,000,000	Funds on Hand \$0	Additional Funds Required \$1,000,000
		Need: The pavement is beginning to deteriorate.			
		Status: No work is underway or scheduled in the six-year Capital Improvement Program. The project will remain on the Capital Project Needs List for future funding consideration.			
DISTRICT 28	PRIORITY # 9	Timberlane Dr at North Klatt Rd Intersection Safety Scope will be identified in a design study phase once funding is provided.	Estimated Cost \$60,000	Funds on Hand \$0	Additional Funds Required \$60,000
		Need: Safety concerns have been raised regarding this intersection.			
		Status: No work is underway or scheduled in the six-year Capital Improvement Program. This project will remain on the Capital Project Needs List for future funding consideration.

DISTRICT 31	PRIORITY # 5	Old Seward Hwy Rut Repair - DeArmoun Rd to Brandon St Scope: This project will construct pavement rehabilitation improvements on a minor arterial street. Improvements are expected to include rut-repair and/or pavement overlay.	Estimated Cost \$650,000	Funds on Hand \$0	Additional Funds Required \$650,000
		Need: Pavement is deteriorating.			
		Status: No work is underway or scheduled in the six-year Capital Improvement Program. This is a state-owned facility and funding would be by the State of Alaska. The route is designated as a minor arterial in the Official Streets and Highways Plan (OS&HP).			
DISTRICT 32	PRIORITY # 3	Rabbit Creek Rd/Southbound off-ramp Signal This project would add a signal at this intersection.	Estimated Cost \$1,000,000	Funds on Hand \$0	Additional Funds Required \$1,000,000
		Need: Interest has been expressed in adding a signal to improve safety.			
		Status: No work is underway or scheduled in the six-year Capital Improvement Program. This is a state-owned facility and funding would be through the State of Alaska.
