Under newly passed Alaska statute 5 AAC 92.104 a few of our wounded soldiers may hopefully have a chance at an Alaska Brown bear while hunting over a bait station this year.

The layout of the lodge allows us the opportunity to take even our paralyzed Service members into this somewhat remote location to enjoy Alaska's Great Outdoors as well as have a chance at an Alaskan black bear in this well known high bear population area of the state.




