**Project Description/Justification:**

Most material site property lines throughout the Northern Region have not been land-surveyed in years and the exact boundaries of almost every site in the region are unknown. This project would provide for a site survey of approximately 18 - 25 material sites throughout the region (mostly sites owned by DOT&PF or Department of Natural Resources, plus some by the Bureau of Land Management) and field reference staking so corners can be recovered well into the future. This information is critical for the future development of Maintenance & Operations (M&O) crushing contracts that serve both federal preventative maintenance projects and M&O's routine maintenance activities. This project will also help to resolve existing, sometimes controversial, land ownership disputes with adjacent landowners.
