**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

This is a new capital request because of a STIP amendment that occurred after the December 15 release of the Governor's FY2012 budget. This project aims to widen, straighten and resurface Glacier Highway from the north Eagle Beach kayak launch site to Bessie Creek to improve safety and provide shoulders. Project includes spot sub-base improvements and drainage improvements as needed. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage and by improving the mobility of people and goods.
