**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

Construct north and southbound weigh stations near the Fort Wainwright Three-Mile Gate, between Fairbanks and North Pole. The weigh stations are needed by the Alaska Division of Measurement Standards and Commercial Vehicle Enforcement to enforce commercial vehicle regulations and to protect public safety. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage and by improving the mobility of people and goods.

**Project Description/Justification:**

To enforce commercial vehicle regulations and to protect public safety the new weigh stations will monitor vehicle size and weight; monitor the amount of time drivers are on the road, as well as driver qualifications; inspect commercial vehicles for maintenance concerns, load security, correct placards; provide safe egress and ingress to and from the Richardson Highway; provide for year-round inspections. The previous weigh stations in this area were removed during the construction of the western Badger Road/Richardson Highway Interchange.

Additional authority is being requested per the latest project cost estimate.
