**Project Description/Justification:**

The proposed wayside upgrades would provide public parking, a picnic shelter, restrooms and interpretive amenities. The present parking lot is poorly drained and comprised of erosive soils with many potholes. The wayside will be connected to the newly renovated and popular Auke Lake trail, the planned multi-use path along Glacier Highway and the UAS campus.

Design should be complete by the fall of 2012, with construction anticipated in spring of 2013.
