# Haines Animal Rescue Kennel - Animal Control Vehicle Conversion

**Brief Project Description:**

Purchase of a four-kennel stainless steel compartment, to be installed into a SUV, for the secure and safe transporting of animals.

**Funding Plan:**

*Funding Details:*

The total cost of the project (\$43,550) is for the purchase of a SUV and an installed four-kennel stainless steel compartment. We have secured \$4,000 of our own funds for the delivery cost of the vehicle to our community. The requested State funding (\$10,550) is for the purchase of a stainless steel kennel compartment to be installed into an SUV. The project deficit (\$29,000) is being requested through another granting agency for the purchase of a SUV.

**Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

The Haines Animal Rescue Kennel, a non-profit 501.c.3, is contracted with the Haines Borough to provide animal control services for the city of Haines. Our current vehicle, a 1998 Ford Explorer, does not provide a safe and disease free environment. The carpeted interior cannot be effectively sanitized to eliminate airborne diseases and animal parasites. And there is only one kennel in the vehicle which is not 100% escape proof nor is it easy for our staff to safely load and off-load animals. The installation of a stainless steel kennel compartment would allow us to safely and effectively handle and transport animals. The kennel unit is designed specifically for animal control. It has four kennel compartments. The kennels are easy to access and have a secure caging system. The installation includes drainage pipes that allow for effective sanitation of the kennels.

**Project Timeline:**

It is estimated that the purchase of the vehicle, production and installation of the kennel compartment and delivery of the finished product will take between six to eight weeks.


