Detailed Project Description and Justification:

This project will install a hard surface pedestrian walkway with barrier curb to separate it from traffic along Gregory Street.

A gravel pathway was created on the west side of Gregory Street in 2011. This is a walking route to students attending Bowman Elementary. The existing pathway has no barrier to prevent traffic from driving/parking on it.

The grant funding may be used for planning, design, utility work, obtaining rights of way and easements, and any activity associated with upgrading the roadway and its amenities.
