



Congratulations for being elected as our legislators! We have greatly appreciated your service to our community and look forward to your leadership through this next decade. We also thank you for your support of ERHS, especially our stadium, and hope this year our legislators will support getting our school and community the facilities they deserve. As you know, this stadium will allow the Anchorage School District (ASD) and community wide youth sports programs to continue to grow to meet participant needs. This past year, the field was constantly in use with various types and levels of youth sports, but lacked the seating, address system, and lighting to allow full use of this great venue for our community. We need a field at ERHS which meets the requirements of statewide competition for all ages in field and track sports.

We are thankful our State has provided us with ERHS as our students, almost 50% of whom are military dependents, lead ASD in most academic categories; but ERHS still needs equitable athletic facilities as other ASD schools (see attachment *ERHS Stadium Committee*). Having this stadium would also allow our students and parents to save the time and costs associated with constant travel for events and practices at other schools, and it would reduce unnecessary risk for our children and families traveling constantly to other venues further away.

Additionally, countless studies and reports have pointed to increased physical activity as one of the primary ways to prevent childhood obesity and to improve discipline. The chronic shortage of facilities to accommodate sports programs in Eagle River prevents sports programs for our youth from reaching their full potential.

As Representatives and Senators known for supporting athletics in our schools, our committee requests your support of the ERHS \$1.4M capital improvement request through ASD for a stadium, which will greatly benefit our youth across Eagle River and Anchorage. This project addresses the current sports facilities shortage at ERHS by providing bleachers, a press box, lights, a public address system, storage, fencing, and security upgrades.






