*Funding Details:**FY2013 Legislative Reappropriation \$500,000***Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

The City's sewage treatment plant has been in violation of its State Discharge Permit since the 1990s, with respect to meeting nitrate levels in groundwater adjacent to the existing drainfields. The City has worked with the State on a number of strategies since that time to address this issue and it has not been resolved. This funding will be used to construct new drainfields upgradient of the monitoring wells (compliance points) that will allow for a greater mixing zone in the groundwater aquifer, improve compliance with the Discharge Permit, and add capacity for future growth.
