## Anchorage - CBERRRSA Sand Storage Building Phase II

Alaska Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (APDES) Permit requires winter sand piles to be covered and heated to reduce need for chlorides.

**Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

CBERRRSA maintained roads extend from Hiland to Eklutna totalling over 180 miles. Several miles are in mountainous areas with steep grades. Winter sand is stored at both the Hiland and Chugiak area storage facilities to reduce hauling costs and response times. Currently winter sand piles are stored outdoors and mixed with sand to prevent freezing.

APDES Permit includes a requirement to enclose winter sand piles to reduce the need for chlorides mixed into the sand. Chlorides leach from material storage facilities into wetlands. Construction of these winter sand storage buildings will ensure compliance with federal stormwater permit requirements.

2013:  
\$1,200,000 Construct new winter sand storage building for Chugiak/Birchwood/Eagle River rural Road Service Area (CBERRRSA)maintenance yards at Lorretta French Park storage Site.
