*Funding Details:**Soldotna Senior Citizens, Inc., has held several fundraisers to remodel and upgrade the men's and women's bathrooms. To date SASCI has raised \$2,000.00.***Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

The mens and womens restrooms need to be remodeled and updated to be fully ADA accessible and compliant. The bathrooms are 22 years old and are very outdated and not fully ADA accessible. There are 6 toilets, a urinal, and 4 hand sinks that need to be removed and replaced. The toilets will be raised to a 19" height, replumbed and refitted with ADA toilets and flush valves. The urinal and flush valve will be replaced as well to ADA compliance. The sinks are in poor condition and the enamel is worn off. They will be replaced with ADA sinks and Lavesafe thermostatic faucets, and bring the drains and supplies up to ADA standards. The counters will be replaced to fit the new ADA hand sinks. There is a shower in each of the bathrooms that will be upgraded by changing existing valves to a pressure balance valve with temperature limiting capabilities and an ADA compliant hand shower. Tile work will be completed around the toilets after the new ADA toilets are installed, as well as in the showers.
