Funding Details:

Our proposed project is new with no funding history. We have obtained commitments of \$216,000 of in-kind materials, donated services, private cash donations and volunteer labor. Private grant funding is currently pending. Based on years of successful grant awards from the Rasmuson Foundation, we are confident that private funding is secure.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

For 50 years, the Nordic Skiing Association of Anchorage (NSAA) has relied primarily on private donations, corporate gifts, foundation grants, and thousands of volunteer hours to build and maintain 100 miles of a world-class trail system. Tens of thousands of residents and visitors alike use these trails year-round for skiing, biking, running and walking. In order to meet community expectations, NSAA is seeking State assistance for the first time in twelve years for trail improvements, grooming equipment upgrades, and jumping facility renovations.

Trail Upgrades: Although Anchorage trail systems are robust, heavily-used trails in the Anchorage Bowl still require renovations and improvements. Trails within the Kincaid, Hillside and Chugiak Municipal trail systems are due for an extensive upgrade to a sustainable standard, which will improve the skiing experience, enhance summer trail use and attract national and international ski competitions, thereby creating an economic benefit for the state and community.

Equipment Upgrades: NSAA constantly evaluates its equipment needs in order to operate in a productive, cost-effective manner and to satisfy the community's increasing expectations for winter grooming in challenging snow conditions. The aging fleet includes machines that are over 25 years old. This capital request includes one new Pisten Bully grooming machine and two new four-stroke snowmachines with grooming attachments.

Ski Jumping Facility Upgrade to Year-Round Facility: Alaska has the only jumping program in the US without access to a year-round training facility; as a result our serious jumpers must train Outside from May to September. Not only will renovations to the Karl Eid Ski Jumps drastically improve access to a quality training facility for our athletes, but they will

also attract national and international competitions, enhancing tourism and bolstering the economy. Specific renovations include stainless steel ski tracks and an artificial landing hill.

Project Timeline:

Our working plan is to implement this project within FY14. Success of this plan will be dependent on the timing of the appropriation, materials availability and weather conditions. Upon commitment of funding, we will immediately commence trail upgrades, make equipment purchases and perform custom modifications, and order jump facility materials. We plan to have equipment operational for the 2013/2014 winter season and trail and jump upgrades completed in the spring of 2014.





Learn to fly – At one time or another, every kid dreams about flying through the air. The NSAA ski jumping program makes those dreams come true. Our trained coaches teach skiers how to execute jumps safely while enjoying the thrill and exhilaration of the flight. There are three jumps at the Karl Eid facility at Hillside: 15, 40 and 64 meters. Three-time Olympian Alan Alborn learned to jump here & currently holds the North American distance record of 221.5 meters.

Cross-Country Skiing

Top notch skiing – Anchorage ski trails are some of the best in the country, and likely some of the most used too. Whether it's the hundreds of kids who learn the fundamentals during Junior Nordic, teens who race with their school, tens of thousands of recreational skiers, or the Olympians who train on Anchorage's trails...NSAA strives diligently to meet the needs of every trail user. Kikkan Randall, Holly Brooks, James Southam and Nina Kempell are just four of the many AK-trained success stories.

Biathlon

Exhilaration and accuracy – Biathlon combines into one sport the exhilaration of cross-country skiing with the accuracy and concentration of shooting. With the world-class facility at Kincaid Park, NSAA has the tools to create a strong program developing athletes for world-class competition, or fun in the winter sun. Jeremy Teela and Jay Hakkinen are AK-trained biathletes who have shown their skills at the Olympic level.

Grooming

There's a Science to it! – NSAA grooms approximately 100 miles of trails in Chugiak, Eagle River, Kincaid Park, Hillside Trail system, Far North Bicentennial Park, Alaska Pacific University and dozens of ASD elementary and middle schools. NSAA's operations team is constantly making decisions about how best to improve conditions for trail users and skiers. Grooming involves extensive understanding and knowledge of snow/ice characteristics and bonding principles. NSAA's winter trail grooming methods are internationally recognized as *the* high standard to meet.

Year-Round Trail Use

Year-round fun! – Anchorage's ski trails are maintained year-round for summer activities as well as wintertime fun. In summer, trails are built and renovated to sustainable standards so winter grooming is more predictable in Anchorage's challenging weather conditions. This means trails are available and widely used by everyone from runners to bikers to disc golfers to hikers to equestrians to adventure racers! Weekly bike and running races are held throughout Anchorage's extensive trail system, thanks to the year-round care by NSAA.

The Next Steps

NSAA prides itself on being self-sufficient. For 50 years, the non-profit has used primarily private donations, and corporate and foundation grants to support its efforts. This funding is supported by thousands of volunteer hours for everything from office work to grooming, trail building to race and event support. To continue upgrading trails, meet community expectations for grooming and expand the jumping program based on community needs,

NSAA is asking the State of Alaska for \$950,000 in the FY14 capital budget.

Trail System Upgrades

Although the system is robust, there are heavily-used trails in the Anchorage Bowl that need to be renovated and improved. Kincaid, Hillside and Chugiak Municipal trail systems are due for an extensive upgrade to a sustainable standard, which will improve the skiing experience, enhance summer trail use and attract national and international ski competitions.

Equipment Purchases

NSAA is constantly evaluating its equipment needs in order to operate in a productive, cost-effective manner and to satisfy the community's increasing level of expectation for winter grooming in challenging snow conditions. The aging fleet includes machines that are over 25 years old. Our Request

NSAA is asking the State of Alaska to invest in Southcentral's extensive multi-use trail system and to help upgrade the equipment fleet and the state's only ski jumping facility. Total project cost of these improvements over the next 5 years will be \$1,166,000. NSAA is requesting \$950,000 in state capital funds that will be matched by \$216,000 in donations, grants and in-kind community support.

Dear Legislator,

The Nordic Skiing Association of Anchorage (NSAA) is seeking a grant in the amount of \$950,000 for trail improvements, equipment purchases and year-round ski jumping.

The work NSAA does is vital to our quality of life in Anchorage. They groom and maintain a hundred miles of trails used by tens of thousands of people winter and summer. They run cross country ski programs including Junior Nordic, biathlon and ski jumping for thousands of Anchorage kids and adults. They plan and organize popular events like the Ski Train, the Ski for Women and the Tour of Anchorage.

They do all of this and more with a \$1.2 million dollar budget funded by donations, grants and revenue generated from events.

The grant funds will be effectively utilized: upgrading the city's most heavily used trails on the Hillside and at Kincaid Park; purchasing a new groomer and snowmachines to replace 25-year-old equipment; and outfitting the Karl Eid Ski Jump Facility on the Hillside with equipment necessary to ski jump year round.

NSAA's last legislative grant was 10 years ago for trail upgrades. This organization does an excellent job delivering services and running programs without government support, but needs this one-time request to complete these projects.

NSAA has a long history of bringing national and international skiing competitions to Anchorage. Dozens of major events over the past 33 years have had an important economic impact on Anchorage's winter economy. These requests will continue to attract national and international events as well as summer jumping competitions, enhancing tourism and helping the economy.

Please consider this important funding request and support this worthy organization.

Dear Legislator,

I am writing in support of the Nordic Skiing Association of Anchorage and their request for state funding for year-round ski jumping.

I am a three-time Olympic ski jumper and hold the North American distance record of 221.5 meters. I've also placed in numerous World Cup ski jumping competitions around the world. But my jumping career started in Anchorage at the Karl Eid Ski Jumps on the Hillside when I was 9 years old.

Now I am head coach of the US Women's Ski Jumping Team, and head coach of jumping and Nordic combined for the Park City Ski Club in Utah.

As coach to some of the nation's best ski jumpers, I can tell you that summer training is a must. Winter snowpack and conditions vary from day to day and year to year. In the summer, ski jumpers can just turn on the sprinklers and go. In fact, most ski jumping training happens in the summer in preparation for winter competitions.

I have been excited to see the resurgence of ski jumping and Nordic combined in Anchorage over the past few years and have been helping your club's efforts in any way I can.

Alaska needs a ski jump facility that is open year round. Ski jumps like these can have a magnetic effect that draws sports enthusiasm and athletes from around the globe, and it gives local athletes a level playing field with the national competition.

I'm hoping you'll see that a relatively small investment to equip the jumps for summer ski jumping will put Anchorage on the map in terms of breeding the next generation of jumping and Nordic combined national champions, and as a place to go to compete at the highest levels.
