Detailed Project Description and Justification:

Upgrade of upper Greer Road from East End Road to Benjamin Avenue. Project will entail replacement of cross culverts and removal of sub-grade in soft spots. Replace driveway culverts that are impeding storm water flow.

Department of Transportation (DOT) removed several soft spots this year and replaced one cross culvert at the Hill Avenue intersection.

An option was brought up to chip seal this road surface instead of asphalt which would cut the cost estimates by a large amount. In previous years the estimates were around 4.5 million dollars. It is believed that this project can now be accomplished for one million dollars or less.

Upon completion it would make financial sense for the State of Alaska to turn over maintenance to the Kenai Peninsula Borough (KPB). As the KPB Roads Department already has to come up Greer Road to access all of the side roads they are responsible for. This would cut down expenses for the State of Alaska and it would be more efficient for the KPB Roads Department.
