CCFR seeks funding for 7 Thermal Imaging Cameras, mounting hardware, and batteries for the first responding apparatus. These cameras allow for rapid searches for victims inside a building that is on fire. They also help locate fires in concealed spaces such as in attics and inside walls. This is critical in a rapid fire attack in close spaces like those found in Juneau's historical district. These buildings have under gone many renovations and have many areas where fire can spread undetected. The cameras will also be used on hazardous materials incidents and searching for victims at car accident scenes and rescue calls.

Currently the department owns two cameras that are 12 years old and spend several months per year out of state for repairs. The cost for 7 cameras is \$40,000.00.

These cameras will help CCFR better protect lives and property.
