Update streetlights and City Hall exterior lighting, with the primary goal of increasing community member safety.

Funding Details:

The City of Adak will provide municipal funds through its 2014 Capital Project budget process for any projected overages.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The City of Adak was forced to disconnect all of the streetlights after the electrical utility was privatized in 2008. The City will reconnect several integral streetlamps using LED technologies to ascertain the ability to reestablish a more comprehensive streetlight system in upcoming years.

The main municipal building, City Hall, houses the school, medical clinic, post office, police station and city administration. It is a community activity hub.

At this time the fixtures are not efficient to re-energize and will be replaced with LED fixtures as compatible with the existing infrastructure. This retrofit will allow City Hall to be adequately lit in the event of emergencies, which occur mainly at night. Community leaders expect it will also deter vandalism to one of the City's most important buildings.

Project and expenditures will occur during Summer and Fall of 2013.


