Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The Native Village of Koyuk is requesting funding to renovate the current Koyuk IRA Office Building. The current Koyuk IRA Building includes the local post office, local government office space, and a large meeting space that was built with the intent to house the Koyuk Head Start Program. The Koyuk IRA Office Building Renovation will include: repairing existing flooring in Head Start designated classroom space, installing child-sized toilet and sink, kitchen upgrade for Head Start area, entryway remodel for Head Start area, and constructing an accessibility ramp on outside of building. The total cost of the project is: \$70,000.

The Koyuk IRA Office Building Renovation Project will allow the Head Start to move from an old and cramped National Guard Armory Building into a new and larger space in the Koyuk IRA Building. The new Head Start space will include a small kitchen, bathroom, classroom space, and office space for teachers. Koyuk's Head Start Program provides early childhood education to approximately 20 children ages 3-4.

The accessibility ramp will allow community members who require special assistance to be able to enter building.

Funding will be used for materials, supplies, and labor.
