Detailed Project Description and Justification:

Project includes a 60'X80' pre-engineered metal building to be used for oil spill response training and for mainline pipeline coating applications.

This grant will complete a 30'x80' classroom and office addition to the existing equipment shop. The project will complete pipeline field operations at the Fairbanks Pipeline Training Center. The oil spill response and mainline pipeline coating facility will be constructed on an existing 2.5 acre pipe yard and will be used for pipeline coating applications. The classroom and office addition will be used to provide on-site instruction for pipeline mechanics.
