*Funding Details:**There is no current funding for this project.***Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

Four local service orgs; American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Disabled American Veterans, and Military Order of the Purple Heart meet in the same building at 12478 Veterans Memorial Hwy in Juneau. These groups serve more than 1800 veterans in the immediate Juneau area. By sharing this facility, the Veterans Center, we are able to share operating cost, and in turn, use those savings to assist local veterans in a variety of ways. For example, we help individuals navigate the VA enrollment system which can be quite challenging. We also provide emergency funds to veterans them for various difficulties.

Our facility is quite old. The present metal roof has many leaks and if not replaced soon will further deteriorate the rest of the structure. Replacement of the roof will allow our groups to continue to serve veterans in Juneau for many years to come.

This funding will be used to secure a certified roofing contractor to provide labor and expertise to remove and dispose of the old roofing materials and to obtain materials necessary to replace with new metal roofing. This will include underlayment, repairs to sub-roof, 3" metal fascia trim. The upper main roof will receive plywood sheeting over existing 2x6 decking. Additional sub-roof repairs may be necessary.
