The propulsion systems of the Patrol Vessel (P/V) Wolstad are overdue for replacement. The engines are several thousand hours overdue for overhaul and due to the antiquity of the engines, parts have to be manufactured and are very expensive. New engines will be approximately 25% more efficient and less expensive to maintain. The propeller and shafting system are also antiquated with parts and service being very difficult to find, making maintenance costs exorbitant. Other mechanical systems, such as generators for the boat are also beyond their useful life and will be replaced.
