Project Description/Justification:

This project will provide a dry sprinkler system for the 17,280 square foot elementary wing of the Nenana Public School complex. This wing was originally built in 1956 with an addition in 1965. It contains classrooms for pre-school through sixth grade and also houses the kitchen, cafeteria, and various other rooms. An August 1999 fire inspection report states that the building is not completely sprinkled and that it has not been free of fires since its last inspection. Proposed cost: \$111,930.
