Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

Additional space for the Alaska State Museum collection, which has grown from 5,600 objects in 1967 to over 25,000 objects currently, is critical to preserving Alaska's history and culture. Accommodating and protecting the current collection while making room for new acquisitions is not possible in the current building, which exceeds capacity. Many artifacts are housed in temporary storage in the parking lot. The building that houses the state archival documents also exceeds capacity and is literally tearing apart. This project will provide funds for design of a facility that will accommodate both the museum and archival needs of the state.
