In FY2000, the department implemented an administrative cost allocation plan (ACAP) that identified the costs of services provided by the Commissioner's Office and the Division of Administrative Services to operating divisions, special funds, and independent agencies. The ACAP was based on actual expenditures for FY97. The department implemented the ACAP to decrease the reliance on general funds for its centralized executive and support functions, allocating the cost for those services to the agencies and industries supported. To reflect changes in department operations, including the recent merger with DCRA and internal reorganizations, the ACAP has now been updated based on FY2000 actual expenditures. As a result of the update, allocated costs for services provided by the Commissioner's Office and the Division of Administrative Services for some divisions and agencies have increased while others have decreased. Increments and decrements are presented in the FY2002 budget request in recognition of these adjustments.
