**Project Description/Justification:**

The Department of Corrections has fifteen (15) Local Community Jail contractors that handle up to 159 state prisoners per day. These facilities have maintenance, renovations and repairs, renewal and replacement, and equipment needs just as much as the State-owned institutional facilities. Items that need to be addressed annually are life and safety equipment, alarm system repairs, sprinkler and ventilation projects, water and sewer equipment, washer and dryer equipment replacement, storage equipment, portable radios, kitchen equipment, booking ID cameras, intercom systems, security equipment and other facility equipment.

For FY2002, the following list the immediate Capital needs of Local Community Jails:

Kodiak Community Jail: \$11,400.00 for floor Tile Replacement, Washer and Dryer, Repaint Interior, Fire System Maintenance.

Dillingham Community Jail: \$32,500.00 for Shower Repairs, Secure Storage Area, Replace Jail Glass with Unbreakable Glass, Renovate Kitchen & Equipment, Fenced Exercise Yard.

Seward Community Jail: \$ 4,000.00 for New Kitchen Range, Kitchen Freezer, General Facility Repairs/Renovations.

Unalaska Community Jail: \$15,900.00 for Safety Glass/Inspection Window; Dish Washer; Cell Entry Protective Gear (3 sets); Security Door Replacement; One-Way mirrored Glass replacement; Video Monitoring systems upgrades.

Wrangell Community Jail: \$25,300.00 for Kitchen Upgrades/Renovations/Remodeling/Equipment; Security Cameras and recorders Replacment / upgrade; New Day room tables, chairs, cabinets; Digital Camera and server for storage of inmate photos and booking information.

Homer Community Jail: \$10,900 for 4 New Stainless Steel Lavatory/Toilet; and 1 stainless steel shower.
